In 2022, the East Hampton Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (EHPRAB) established the Jeffrey Leith Memorial Scholarship. Jeff was a beloved member of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and the president of the Hawks Youth Football Organization. The scholarship is intended for an East Hampton resident scholar athlete who honors Jeff's legacy through their dedication to learning and leadership. The scholarship is intended for a student who plans to further their education with an undergraduate degree, or who plans to enter the military service.

The criteria for this scholarship are:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior and East Hampton resident who has lettered in any varsity sport for two or more seasons.
- Applicant must have plans to attend the Military, a technical school, college or university in the fall of his/her graduating year.
- Applicant must complete the application and attach a short essay (no more than 300 words)
- Applicant must have a current GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- Applicant must submit one letter of recommendation from an Athletic Coach.

The deadline for applications is May 1, 2025. All applications will be reviewed by a committee established by the EHPRAB. Committee members reviewing applications cannot have a graduating senior applying.

This scholarship is funded by money that has been raised by the East Hampton Parks and Recreation Department and sponsor donations. The amount of the scholarship will be based on the financial standing of the East Hampton Parks and Recreation Special Revenue Account each year and will be voted on annually by charter members.
